

Tickets to Bohemians 1905 Prague at Ďolíček.

The stadium.

There are 3 areas at Ďolíček for home supporters to watch the game.

Stand A – This is the large all seated “stand”. Use entrance 1 for this stand.

Stand B – This is mainly standing with a few seats to one side. Use entrance 3 for this stand. This is where the most ardent Bohemians fans go. (They are a good crowd, and you will not get any issues. Expect to smell cannabis though.)

Stand C – This is a small, seated area that has just been reopened this season. Use entrance 3 for this stand.

Stand D – **This is for away supporters only!**

Getting to the stadium.

You could easily walk to the stadium. It would take around 40 minutes from Wenceslas Square to get to the stadium.

There is a tram and bus stop right outside the ground called, appropriately enough, Bohemians.

The following Trams will take you to this stop.

6 – This tram goes through the city center and right across Wenceslas Square.

7 – This tram starts on the west side of the river leaving from Radlická and going through Anděl before crossing the river. It does not take in the city centre.

19 – This tram starts on the east side of the city. It does not go through the city center.

95 – This is the night service (After midnight). You should not need this.

Getting tickets.

For most games at Ďolíček you should be able to pay at the gate. A lot will depend on how the club are doing, like most clubs everywhere in the world. The games that you will find near impossible to get tickets for are Slavia Prague and Sparta Prague.

To ensure that you have a ticket the best place to get tickets in advance is through <https://www.ticketportal.cz/sport/fotbal> Tickets usually go on sale here about 2 weeks before the game. (This can vary but is never shorter than 2 weeks.)

If you are looking at purchasing a large amount of tickets this can be done on Ticketportal or email the ticket secretary at ticketing@bohemians1905.cz I am informed that she does speak some English.

If you monitor the club website's fixtures page any ticketing instruction will be listed for the game. (Click on "VSTUPENKY" and it will take you to the relevant game and any info for getting tickets.)

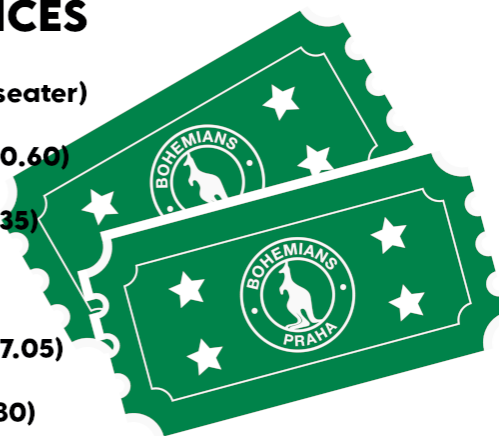
